Internships - 2019

Overview:

Gentle Road is a dynamic inner city ministry in Regina, SK, Canada. We work primarily among the urban disadvantaged and also among Indigenous Canadian peoples. Gentle Road is seeking one intern for the winter/spring/summer of 2019, to work primarily among our youth.

The ideal candidate will have a deep love for the Lord, a passion for ministry and a heart for the inner city. He/she will also have 20-40 hours/week to devote to ministry. Male and female applicants are welcome to apply. Candidates can be either Canadian or international.

Goals:

- 1. We will work and pray together for the spiritual transformation of the youth
- 2. We will intentionally develop leaders and servants among the youth
- 3. We will reach out to love the community and invite them into relationship with Christ
- 4. We will help the youth grow in mission, service, worship and numbers

Requirements: The ideal candidate will:

- 1. Be immersed into Christ, and have a personal and growing relationship with Him
- 2. Desire to share their lives with the people of North Central Regina, and among Indigenous peoples
- 3. Be able to teach the youth and make disciples
- 4. Have their driver's license, have a good driving record, and be able to drive 15 passenger vans (one at a time!)
- 5. Be at least 19 years of age
- 6. Provide a criminal record and vulnerable sector check

We value:

- 1. Prayer and the Word of God
- 2. Ethnic diversity
- 3. Listening deeply, to God and to people
- 4. Involving the community in the development and carrying out of ministries

What does the work involve?

- 1. The schedule will be customized, depending on needs and time availability. We are planning the following for the summer of 2019:
 - a. Participating with our high school students in serving at Vacation Bible Schools
 - b. Mission 6:10 our annual inner city mission camp
 - c. Attending Heritage Bible camp together
 - d. Going to the local school to help with programs there

- 2. Each intern will participate in evening ministries on a weekly basis, in collaboration with Kevin. (4-6 hours/evening, including planning and follow-up):
 - a. Mondays The Party, kindergarten-grade 5
 - b. Tuesdays Youth group, grades 6-8
 - c. Wednesdays High school group
 - d. Thursdays Adult Bible study
 - e. Sundays Evening worship
 - f. Weekends some trips/events
- 3. Meet 1x/week to plan and pray (2 hours)
- 4. Visit personally with youth or adults for mentoring, leadership development and prayer (variable)
- 5. Each intern will have 1-2 sabbath days/week
- 6. Other duties as negotiated

Term Positions:

These are term positions for the winter/spring/summer of 2019. Their duration is 8 months. Exact start and end dates are flexible. Remuneration for Canadian applicants is minimum wage, \$15/hour, plus some expenses. However, in order to be selected, the candidate must be able to raise the necessary funds to pay for their wages.
